

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



Reference No. 211/D/127

In the Matter of Land at Greenside, Waskerley,  
Healyfield, Co. Durham

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.110 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Durham County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 162 made by Mr A J R Collins, Mr D A Gray, and the Hon. R. O. Stanley, and noted in the Register on 12 October 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Durham on 3 July 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr C J Thompson, Solicitor, on behalf of the Objectors. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr and Mrs T Vivers, the Successors in title of Mr J Holland, the applicant for the registration.

I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
