DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entries No. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 60 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Durham County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 55 made by the Minister of Agriculture and noted in the Register on 2 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Darlington on 23 July 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr L Pattinson, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of the applicants for registration, or their successors. The parties had agreed that the registrations should be confirmed and I confirm them accordingly.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
