In the Matter of Sand Edge Common, Wolsingham, Co. Durham (No. 2)

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 3 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 48 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Durham County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 44 made by Mr T R F Fenwick and noted in the Register on 1 February 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Durham on 9 October 1980. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard but in letters dated 2 and 3 October 1980 Mrs M Beveridge, the widow of Mr F Beveridge, the applicant for the registration, stated that she wished to withdraw her claim.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
