

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 211/D/154

In the Matter of The Commons, Hutton Henry, Co. Durham (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 64 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Durham County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 114 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Durham on 1 July 1980. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard.

There are two entries in the Rights Section of the Register Unit. There is no Objection relating to either of these entries, which will therefore have to be confirmed either in the Register of Common Land or in the Register of Town or Village Greens. There being no evidence in support of the conflicting registration, it follows that this land falls within the definition of "Common Land" in Section 22(1) of the Commons Registration Act 1965 by being land subject to rights of common which is not a Town or Village Green.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of hw may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
