



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of The Green, Dalton-le-  
Dale, Co. Durham (No. 3)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 86 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Durham County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 47 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Durham on 1 July 1980. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard.

For the reasons given in my decision in In the Matter of The Green, Dalton-le-Dale (No. 1) (1980), Reference No. 211/D/151, I have refused to confirm the conflicting registration.

Since but for the conflicting registration the registration would have become final for want of an objection, it appears to me that my proper course is to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
