

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.37/D/79

In the Matter of Piltdown Common,

Maresfield and Fletching, and

Grisling Common, Fletching, East Sussex(No.5)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.9 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.30 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former East Sussex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.219 made by the Trustees of the Piltdown Golf Club and noted in the Register on 14th August 1972.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that there is no person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest, or part of the interest of any other person.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration with the following modification:-namely, in column 4 of the Rights Section of the Register Unit, for the words "over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit" there shall be substituted the words "that part of the land comprised in this register unit not hatched red on the register map".
