

In the Matter of Colchester Green, Elmstead, Essex (No. 3)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 2 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. VG 14 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Essex County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Colchester on 17 March 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr A Wilde, solicitor, on behalf of Mrs M E Betts, the applicant for the registration, and I very reluctantly gave leave for Mr C M D Gooch, the applicant for the conflicting registration, to be represented by Mr R K Nabbet, a chartered surveyor.

The facts of this dispute are set out in my decision in <u>In the Matter of Colchester Green</u>, <u>Elmstead (No. 2)</u> (1981), Ref. Nos 212/D/230 and 232. For the reasons there stated I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
