

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 212/D/-98-101

In the Matter of Fordham Heath Eight Ash Green Colchester BC

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No VG 187 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Essex County Council and is occasioned by (Objections Nos 503 and 504 both made by Robert Leonard Nominees Ltd and both noted in the Register on 31 July 1973 and objections Nos 487 and 488 both made by Mrs I W King and both notes on the Register on 31 July 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Colchester on 25 July 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr J G Wilson of Messrs Thompson Smith & Puxon on behalf of the Parish Council and Mr H M Hayes of Messrs Goody Bentley & Sons on behalf of Mr A C Salmon. Mrs King had withdrawn her objection prior to the hearing and Robert Leonard Nominees Ltd the other objector did not appear in these circumstances I have no alternative but to confirm the Registration.

Mr Salmon was not a person entitled to be heard at this hearing. concerned to appear when the question of the ownership of the green comes to a hearing and if he wishes to be given notice of that hearing he should notify the office of the Commons Commissioners to that affect.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
