



In the Matter of Land near to the "Green Man" Public House,
Herongate, Brentwood, Essex.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. VG 72 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Essex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 120 made by Lord Petre and noted in the Register on 27 October 1970.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that there is no person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest, or part of the interest of any other person.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration with the following modifications:- namely, the substitution of the words "District Council of Brentwood" for the words "Brentwood Urban District Council", the substitution of the word "part" for the word "whole" and the addition of the words "shown edged and hatched red on the plan annexed to the particulars of terms signed by the Rt. Hon. Joseph William Lionel, Baron Petre and on behalf of the District Council of Brentwood".
