



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 5 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 64 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Essex County Council and are occasioned by Objection Nos 9 and 56 both made by Mr C J W Everitt and respectively noted in the Register on 6th June 1969 and 22nd August 1970 and by the conflicting registration at Entry No 5 in the Land Section of Register Unit No VG. 66 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely the exclusion of the land the subject of Mr Everitt's Objections, being the ditch on the north-west side of Mr Everitt's property known as Oaklands.
