



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entries No. 1 and No. 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 339 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Essex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 356 made by D M Camp, E H Camp and J D Camp and noted in the Register on 14 April 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chelmsford on 19 February 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr J G Clegg, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of the Objectors.

Entries No. 1 and No. 2 are of grazing rights and were both made on the application of R J Carter and E H Carter, who were not present or represented at the hearing. The Objection is on the grounds that the rights do not exist, and in the absence of any evidence to support the registrations, I refuse to confirm them.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
