## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 310 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Essex County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 187 made by Mr M J Jones and noted in the Register on 29 October 1970 and the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No VG 144 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Countil.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Colchester on 18 March 1981. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard, but heard, but hearing I was given a document signed on behalf of the Sible Hedingham Parish Council and by the applicants for the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of the Register Unit and by the Objectors asking me to confirm the registration with the following modification, namely, the exclusion of the land the subject of the Objection. This I do in the absence of any appearance on behalf of the other concerned authorities.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations. 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
