



In the Matter of Southey Green, Sible Hedingham,  
Essex (No. 3)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 144 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Essex County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 185 made by Mr M J Jones and noted in the Register on 29 October 1970 and the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 310 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Colchester on 18 March 1981. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard but before the hearing I was given a document signed on behalf of the Sible Hedingham Parish Council, the applicants for the registration, and by the applicants for the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 310 and the Objector asking me to refuse to confirm the registration. In the absence of any opposition by the other concerned authorities, I therefore refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
