

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965.

Reference No. 212/D/272

In the Matter of Two pieces of land to the North of St. Germains Church. Bobbingworth

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.449 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Esser County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 362 made by Prebendary A.S. Hopkinson and noted in the Register on 5 April 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chelmsford on 17 November 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr J R M Brown, Solicitor for Essex County Council and the Reverend A E Harvey Rector of Bobbingworth.

I was informed that all parties had agreed that the registration should be confirmed subject to the exclusion of the larger of the two pieces of land.

For these reasons I confirm the registration subject to the deletion from the Register plan of the larger of the two pieces of land.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
