

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

213/D/173-174

In the Matter of Lower Cow Pasture, Shuthongor Common, and Cowham Twyning, Gloucestershire (NO.1)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No I in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.46 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Gloucestershire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. OB 133 made by Mr B C Ball and noted in the Register on 22 December 1970, and Objection No. Ob.22 made by Miss R D Wigan and noted in the Register on 14 May 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Cheltenham on 28 and 29 March 1979 and at Watergate House, WC2 on 9 and 10 April 1979. The hearing was attended by Miss Shelia Cameron, of Counsel, on behalf of Mr C E Passey and C W Passey, in consequence of whose application for a registration in the Rights Section of the Register Unit this registration was made, and by Mr Martin Roth, of Counsel, on behalf of the Objector.

It was proved by evidence that most of the land comprised in the Register Unit is subject to rights of common, but it was agreed during the hearing that certain small portions of the land ought to be excluded from the registration.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modifications: namely the exclusion of the areas marked "" and "" on Plan No. 1 attached to on the property known as Jordan's Cottage.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 5 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
