

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 213/D/75 and 76

In the Matter of Roadside Waste Redmarley D' Abitot Forest of Dean D.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entries No 1 in the Land Section and No 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.292 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Gloucestershire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. Ob 424 made by the Gloucestershire County Council and noted in the Register on 15 February 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Gloucester on 17 October 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr Limbrick on behalf of the County Council and Mr R G Wood of Messrs. Humberts on behalf of Miss D G Albright who registered the land as common land, claimed common rights and also claimed to be the owner.

Mr Wood accepted that all the unit land lying to the East of the road 3/63 and an 8ft strip adjoining the said road on its West Side is highway land, and with the agreement of Mr Limbrick I confirm the Entry in the Land Section modified so as to exclude the said highway land.

Miss Albrights Entry in the Ownership Section being unopposed is now final insofar as it relates to the modified Entry in the Land Section and since she is the owner she can have no common rights and I refuse to confirm the Entry in the Rights Section.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
