In the Matter of Rosamunds Green, Frampton-on-Severn, Gloucestershire (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 284 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Gloucestershire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 117 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Gloucester on 8 February 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr Frank Powell, the Chairman of the Frampton-on-Severn Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, and Mr F C Penley, solicitor, on behalf of Mrs H H E C Clifford, in pursuance of whose application the conflicting registration was made.

For the reasons given in my decision in <u>In the Matter of Rosamunds Green, Frampton-on-Severn (No. 1)</u>, (1977) Ref. No. 213/D/44 I have decided that the land comprised in the Register Unit is a town or village green.

A town or village green is excluded from the definition of "common land" in section 22(1) of the Commons Registration Act 1965, so I therefore refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 5 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
