



In the Matter of Selsley Common, King's Stanley,  
Gloucestershire (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 2 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Gloucestershire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. Ob.86 made by the former County Council as highway authority and noted in the Register on 5 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Gloucester on 10 February 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr A C Parker, legal executive of the Stroud District Council, the successor of the former Stroud Rural District Council, the applicant for the registration. Mr Parker informed me that the District Council was willing that the Objection should be met in part by the exclusion from the Register Unit of the metalled carriageway of Route No. B 4066, leaving within the Register Unit the scheduled rights of way which were also the subject of the Objection.

There being no appearance on behalf of the County Council to support the Objection in so far as it related to the rights of way, I confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely, the exclusion of the metalled carriageway of Route No. B.4066.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
