

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.213/D/26

In the Matter of Village Green, Little Barrington, Barrington, Stroud District

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG. 47 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Gloucestershire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.85 made by the Gloucestershire County Council and noted in the Register om 11th November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Gloucester on 18th February 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr.Limbrick on behalf of the Gloucestershire County Council.

The Barrington Parish Council had prior to the hearing agreed in writing to the exclusion of the land identified on the plan annexed to Objection No.85 from the registration as forming part of a highway.

For this reason I confirm the registration modified so as to exclude the land identified on the plan annexed to Objection No.85.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
