

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.55/U/8

In the Matter of Old Church Green, Penallt, Trellech.

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Old Church Green cenallt in Trellach United Parish being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register in No.VG.3 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Monmouthshire county Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration at 1965 as the owner.

ollowing upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold wner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the and at Monmouth on 3rd October 1973. Mr.Davies, the clerk of Trellech United Parish ouncil, attended the hearing and informed me that there was no evidence of ownership. here was no other appearance.

or these reasons I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land nd I shall accordingly direct the Monmouthshire County Council as registration authority, o register Trellech United Parish Council as the owner of the land under section 8 (3) f the Act of 1965.

am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain hat a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a ase for the decision of the High Court.
