



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 55/D/2

In the Matter of Twyn-Yr-Allws Common, Llanfoist
Fawr, Gwent (No.2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.7 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Monmouthshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 72 made by Mr W. J. Lewis and noted in the Register on 27 October 1970.

Mr Commissioner Settle, Q.C., held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Cardiff on 29 November 1979. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard, but Solicitors acting for Mr Lewis's successor in title informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners by letter dated 21 November 1979 that their client did not wish to pursue his objection.

The learned Commissioner was killed in a road accident after the hearing without having given his decision. I hereby direct in pursuance of reg. 29 of the Commons Commissioners Regulations that the proceedings shall be continued by myself.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
