

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965 DECISION (DISPUTE)

In the Matter of Bwlch Cwm Brithdir and Islawrdref Meironnedd D

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No.1 in the Land Section, Entry No.1 in the Rights Section and Entry No.1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No.CL103 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council and are occasioned by Objections Nos. 476 and 477 both made by H.A. and R.B. Evans and both noted in the Register on 12 September 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Dolgellau on 5th November 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr K.E. Barnett counsel instructed by Messrs Humphreys and Farsons on behalf of H.A. and R.B. Evans and by Mr T.M. Wynne of Messrs J. Charles Hughes & Co on behalf of T. Nightingale.

Mr Wynne explained that there was some confusion as regards the Registers of Units Nos. 103 and 150. Mr Barnett was content that I should exclude the land the subject of Mr Nightingale's ownership claim from this Unit CL 103 and that I should confirm the Entry at No.1 in the Land Section modified so as to exclude that land.

For this reason I confirm the Entry at No.1 in the Land Section modified so as to exclude the land identified on the plan annexed to the Nightingale's application No. 555 dated 22nd December 1969 and I confirm the Entry at No.1 in the Rights Section as applicable to the modified Entry in the Land Section. The land claimed by Mr Nightingale being excluded from this Unit the Entry at No.1 in the Ownership Register will become void.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
