



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 215 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 285 made by the National Farmers Union and noted in the Register on 21 April 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dolgellau on 8 February 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr D Williams on behalf of the National Farmers Union. Mr Williams produced a consent signed by all the parties entitled to be heard, other than the Brithdir and Islawrdref Community Council requesting me to refuse to confirm the Registration. The land was registered by the Ramblers' Association who consented.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
