

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.274/U/26

In the Matter of Cefn Caer-Buni, Llanfor and Llandderfol Merionnydd D.

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Cefn Caer-Euni Llanfor and Llandderfol, Meirionnydd D. being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.73 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference P J Summers claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Dolgellau on 19th April 1977.

Fir J Southam of Messas. Slater HeelEs and Co., appeared for Mr P J Summers and produced a conveyance dated 25 March 1963, with plan attached, made between the personal representative of MF / reque decoased and F J Summers whereby the land in question identified on the said plan was conveyed to P J Summers.

On this evidence I am satisfied that I J Summers is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Baynedd County Council, as registration authority, to register 2.4 Bummers as the owner of the land under section 8 (2) of the Act of 1965.

I am respired by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in roint of law may, within 5 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is cent to him, require me to state a case for the occision of the High Court.
