

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 274/D/101 & 102

In the Matter of Craigyllyn Mountain, Llanddwywe-is-y-Graig, Meirionnydd D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No CL. 58 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 126 made by H J Wynne and noted in the Register on 10 November 1970 and Objection No 127 made by Mrs Kate Roberts noted in the Register on 10 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dolgellau on 21 April 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr J B Williams of Messrs Richard Williams on behalf of Mr Marian Ratcliffe the successor to Gwada Iris Jones who claimed ownership of part of the land by Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section. Mr D R Jones of Messrs Guthrie Jones and Jones appeared for Mrs Roberts one of the Objectors who by her objection, but not by any entry in the Register claimed ownership of part of the land, as also did the other Objector Mr H T Wynne who did not appear.

Eaving come to the conclusion that I could not confirm the Registration on the evidence available at the hearing and since the Entry in the Land Section is final, and there will on any view have to be a Reference under Section 3 of the Act of 1965, it was agreed by the parties attending that the convenient course was to refuse to confirm the Registration, such refusal being without prejudice to such claims as Mrs Ratcliffe, Mrs Roberts and Mr H T Mynne may put forward on the Reference under Section 3.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
