DECISION (UNCLAIMED LAND)

Reference No. 54/U/7

In the Matter of Graienyn Mountain
Llangower Meirionnydd D

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Graienyn Mountain Llangower Meirionnydd D being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL/67 in the Register of Common Land/Town or Village Greens maintained by the former Merioneth County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Mrs C.P. Morris, Mr H.E. Morris and Mrs D.B. Mierczynka claimed to be the freehold owners of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Dolgellau on 5th November 1975.

Mr C.R. Lloyd of Messrs Guthrie Jones and Jones appeared for Mrs. C.P. Morris, Mr H.E. Morris and Mrs D.B. Mierczynka and produced two conveyances to them by Glanllyn Ltd dated respectively 26 February 1971 and 24 September 1973 whereby the land in question was conveyed to his clients the claimants for ownership. The land was identified by plans on the said conveyances.

On this evidence I am satisfied that Mrs C.P. Morris, Mr H.E. Morris and Mrs D.B. Mierczynka are the owners of the land under section 8(2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
