DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 62-63 and 64 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 45 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council and are occasioned by the Objections set out in the Schedule hereto.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Dolgellau on 10 February 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr H Davies on behalf of H & T M Griffiths, R Lloyd and D M Tudor. Prior to the hearing Mr I Ephraim withdrew his Objection No 52. Mr Davies informed me that all the parties to these disputes had arrived at an agreement and at his request I confirm Entry No 62 and I confirm Entry No 64 modified so that the right of grazing shall be limited to 150 sheep and I refuse to confirm Entry No 63.
