



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference 54/D/70

In the Matter of Gwastadros Llanycil
Meirionydd D.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 16 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.47 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Meirioneth County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 70 made by Wally Jones and noted in the Register on 13 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dolgellau on 13 December 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr R J Thomas of Messrs. W Edwards and Co. on behalf of Mr Holt the successor to Mrs H M Johnston the applicant for Rights under Entry No. 16.

Mr Thomas said he also acted for other graziers on the common and that Mr Holts entitlement to grazing rights was not contested and that Quantum was the only matter in dispute which he was confident could be agreed at a meeting of graziers to be held in the near future.

In order to avoid a further adjourned hearing I agreed to confirm Entry No. 16 to be modified as agreed. Mr Thomas agreed to send to the office of the Commons Commissioners an agreement signed by the Secretary of the Gwastadros Sheep Graziers Association of the agreed modification. I must ask Mr Thomas to send this agreement as soon as possible.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
