

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 50/U/24

In the Matter of Gwinllan Bach. Rhydyclafdy

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Gwinlland Bach, Rhydyclafdy, being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 18 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Caernarvonshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Caernarvon on 30th anuary 1973. No person attended the hearing to claim ownership of the land in question or any part thereof.

For these reasons I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Caernarvonshire County Council, as registration authority, to register Buan Parish Council as the owner of the land under section ნ(უ) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
