DECISION

This dispute relates to (1) the registration at Entry No. Al8 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 18 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Caernarvonshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. 0.4 and 0.14 made by Mrs W A Bean and others and A J Carmell respectively and noted in the Register on 18 September 1969 and 8 April 1970 and the conflicting registration at Entry No. V/A2 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 2 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

(1) The registration at Entry Nos. 1, 2 and 3 in the Rights section of Register Unit CL 18 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the said County Council and is occasioned by objections nos. 0/4, 0/14 and 0/41 made by Mrs W A Bean and others, A J Carmell and Messrs Banister and King respectively and noted in the Register on 18 September 1969, 8 April 1970 and 28 September 1970 and the conflicting registration at Entry No. V/A2 in the Land Section of Register Unit Mo. VG 2 in the Register of Town or Village Green maintained by the said Council and (3) the registration at Entry No. V/A2 in the Land section of Register Unit VG 2 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the said County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. 0/5 and 0/15 made by Tirs 7 A Bean and others and A J Carnell respectively and noted in the Register on 18 September 1969 and 8 April 1970 and the conflicting registration at Entry No. AlC in the Land section of Register Unit No. Cl 18 in the Register of Tormon Land maintained by the said County Council.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clark of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that every person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest or part of the interest, of any other person has consented in writing to the proposed terms.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly refuse to confirm any of the said registrations.
