

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 50/D/23

In the Matter of land known as Rhos Porth Ychain, Penlloch, Tudweiliog

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No VG 5 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Caernarvonshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 122 made by Mr A.C.Street and noted in the Register on 30th September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Caernarvon on 50th January 1973. The hearing was attended by Mr R. G. Woolley of Counsel, instructed by Messrs. I.ap. G. Hughes and J Elwyn Williams, Solicitors, on behalf of the Objector.

For the reasons appearing from my decision under the Reference No 50/D/22 I refuse to confirm the registration.

I make no order for costs in this case, because it appears that Hr Street has no proprietory interest in the land.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in roint of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
