



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 50/D/1

In the Matter of Land
known as Traeth-y-Foryd in
the Parish of Llanwnda

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. C.L.95 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Caernarvonshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 23 made by the Public Trustee and noted in the Register on 14th January 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bangor on 5th December 1972. The hearing was attended by Mr. W.H. Jones, Clerk to Llanwnda Parish Council, and Mr. R.M. Rutherford for the Public Trustee.

Mr. W.H. Jones, who is the present clerk to Llanwnda Parish Council, told me that the registration of the land edged yellow on the plan annexed to Objection No. 23 by the Public Trustee had been made in error, and he asked me to refuse confirmation.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
