



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entrys Nos. 1 and 4 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No.CL.116 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council and are the said conflicting registration at Entrys No 1 and 4 in the said Ownership Section of this register unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dolgellau on 21st April 1977. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard. Mr D Williams of the N F U attended on behalf of J F Williams-Mynne the applicant under Entry No 1 and R L Pughe the applicant under Entry No.4 in person who withdrew his claim to ownership.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration at Entry No. 4 and confirm the Entry No.1.

I am required by regulation 50 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
