



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 274/U/60

In the Matter of Mynydd Llanegryn,  
Community of Llangelynin

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of the land described above being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 159 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Mr E J N Kirby claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Dolgellau on 29 April 1980.

At the hearing Mr John Williams of the firm of Williams and Hancock, Solicitor, appeared on behalf of Mr Kirby and said that the claim to ownership was withdrawn. There was no other appearance.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
