



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 6 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No.CL.117 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 489 made by J G Evans and noted in the Register on 14 September 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dolgellau on 21st April 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr D Williams of the N F U on behalf of J F Williams Wynn who claimed ownership under the said Entry No. 6. The objector Mr J G Evans *having* by his solicitors Messrs. Williams and Hancock letters dated 28 March 1977 withdrawn his objection.

I confirm the registration at Entry No. 6.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of Law, may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
