DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and Entry No 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 178 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 241 made by the Bridgewood Forestry Syndicate and noted in the Register on 25 February 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dolgellau on 9 February 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr D Williams on behalf of Mr J E Charlton the applicant for rights and by Mr T M Wynne of Messrs J Charles Hughes & Co on behalf of Economic Forestry Ltd the successor to The Bridgewood Forestry Syndicate.

Mr Williams on behalf of his client agreed that I should refuse to confirm both Entries and I therefore refuse to confirm the Entry No 1 in the Land Section and the Entry No 1 in the Rights Section.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
