

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 274/D/176

In the matter of Piece of land beach at Llaneiniog, Llangoed and Civic Parish of Llanfaes, Ynys Mon BC

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No A.44 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 44 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Anglesey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No O/34 made by Sir Richard Williams-Eulkeley Bt and noted in the Register on 28 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llangefni on 23 and 24 March 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr E L Gilson who appeared for Ynys Mon BC on 23 and 24 March. Mr Forcer Evans of Messrs Laurie & Co appeared for Sir Richard Williams-Bulkeley Bt on 23 March and Mr J L Williams, Mr O T Rowlands and Mr Emrhys Owen appeared for Llangoed Community Council.

The circumstances in which this dispute came to be heard on 23 and 24 March were the same as those in the case of Unit CL. 43.

In this case as in the case of Unit CL. 43 there are no Entries in the Rights Section of the Register and Er Gilson's researches had not disclosed any evidence that the land is waste of a manor and I have therefore no alternative but to refuse to confirm the registration. If an application is made to reopen the hearing before I give by direction on the ground that further evidence has come to light, I will consider any such application on its merits.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1771 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
