



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 274/D/41 and 42

In the Matter of Rhiw Mountain,  
Aberdaron and Botunnog, Dwyfor D

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and Entry Nos 1 to 10 inclusive in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 13 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Caernarvonshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No 93 made by the Gwynedd Police Authority and noted in the Register on 30 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Pwllheli on 25 May 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr D G Linton on behalf of the Gwynedd Police Authority and Mr I E Owen appeared for the applicants for rights under Entry No 3 in the Rights Section of the Register. Mr Owen agreed to the exclusion of the land the subject of the Objection being excluded from the land registered as common land in the Land Section and all the other applicants for rights had agreed in writing to the exclusion of that land.

For this reason I confirm the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section with the following modification viz the exclusion of the land identified on the plan annexed to Objection No 93 being the fenced-in CPA YAF Station and I confirm the Entries at Nos 1 to 10 inclusive in the Rights Section applicable the land at Entry No 1 in the Land Section as modified.

I am required by regulation 50(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
