

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 54/D/24 & 25

In the Matter of The Saddle, Cader Idris, Brithdir & Islaw'rdref, Meirionnydd D

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and No 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 150 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council and are occasioned by Objection No 229 made by E M Jones and noted in the Register on 15 January 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dolgellau on 29 July 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr T M Wynne of Messrs J Charles Hughes & Co on behalf of Mr Nightingale the applicant for rights. The Objector did not appear. Mr Wynne informed me that Mr Nightingale did not oppose Mr Jones' Objection and for this reason I confirm the Entry at No 1 modified so as to exclude the land the subject of Mr Jones' Objection identified on the plan annexed to that Objection and I confirm the Entry at No 1 in the Rights Section as applicable to the modified Entry in the Land Section.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
