



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 274/D/188 and 191 to 201

In the Matter of Towyn Trewan Common, Llechylched  
Yn Neubwll and Llanfaelog Ynys Mon D

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. A34 in the Land Section and all the subsisting Entries in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.34 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Anglesey County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 016 made by H J Enston and noted in the Register on 22 September 1969 and the conflicting registration at Entries Nos. 85-190 and 85 and 192 and 86 and 193 and 147 and 196 and 190 and 192 in the Rights Section of this unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bangor on 22 May 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr J A Williams of Messrs. S R Dew Prothero and Williams on behalf of the Towyn Trewan Conservators.

Mr Williams informed me that Mr Enston has died and that he had been in communication with his successor Mrs Enston who did not appear to support her objection. For this reason I confirm the Entry in the Land Section and all the subsisting Entries in the Rights Section, save as hereinafter mentioned. As regards the conflicting Entries it was agreed between the Conservators and the Meyrick Estate that I should refuse to confirm Entries Nos. 190, 192 and 193. Mr Rowlands the applicant under Entry No. 196 did not appear and I refuse to confirm that Entry.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
