

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference 274/U/19

In the Matter of Tyucha Sheepwalk, Llanymawddwy, Meirionnydd D

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Tyucha Sheepwalk, Llanymawddwy, Meirionnydd D being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 119 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Miss C Hughes and Miss L M Hughes claimed to be the freehold owners of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Dolgellau on 30 July 1976.

Mr G Lloyd of Messrs Guthrie Jones and Jones appeared for Miss C Hughes and Miss L M Hughes and produced a conveyance dated 25 March 1939 which included the land in question which was identified on the plan on that conveyance. Mr Lloyd produced the subsequent documents of title the last of which is an appointment of Miss C Hughes and Miss L M Hughes as new trustees.

On this evidence $^{\rm I}$ am satsified that Miss C Hughes and Miss L M Hughes are the owners of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Gwynedd County Council, as registration authority, to register Miss $^{\rm C}$ Hughes and Miss L M Hughes as the owners of the land under section 8(2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
