

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 54/D/68 & 69

In the Matter of Y Trinant & Moel Llyfnant, Llanycil, Meirionnydd D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 185 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 150 made by J E Charlton and noted in the Register on 1 December 1970 and Objection No 255 made by the Merioneth Branch of the NFU and entered in the Register on 25 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dolgellau on 9 February 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr D Williams on behalf of the NFU and Mr Charlton. The Ramblers' Association had prior to the hearing signed a consent to my giving a decision refusing to confirm the registration and at the request of Mr Williams I take that course.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
