



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 214/D/24 & 25

In the Matter of Hook Common (Part)
Hook, Mapledurwell and Upnately
Hart DC and Basingstoke DC

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 and the Land Section and Entry No 16 in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 167 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hampshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No OB 133 made by Messrs Walford Hart and noted in the Register on 16 December 1969).

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Winchester on 3 May 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr P R Fitzgerald of Messrs Walters Vandercom & Hart on behalf of the objectors who produced a request signed by Mr R C Rose the applicant for rights under Entry No 16 in the Rights Section that I should refuse to confirm that Entry. Therefore in the absence of any other subsisting Entry in the Rights Section and since no concerned authority attended the hearing at the request of Mr Fitzgerald I refuse to confirm the Entry in the Land Section and Entry No 16 in the Rights Section.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
