COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Kingston Lower Common, Ringwood, Hampshire

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 178 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hampshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. OB. 240 made by Mr D Milligan and noted in the Register on 26 August 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Winchester on 21 March 1984. The hearing was attended by Mr E Mason, Assistant County Secretary, on behalf of the Hampshire County Council as registration authority, the registration having been made without application, and by Mr V Chapman, of Counsel, on behalf of the Objector.

Mr Mason informed me that he was instructed not to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
