

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Land near Lower Whiteflood Farm, Owslebury, Winchester CC

## DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Land near Lower Whiteflood Farm, Owslebury, Winchester CC being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL. 231 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hampshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Owslebury Parish Council claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Winchester on 3 March 1976.

Mr J H Shaw the chairman of the Owslebury Parish Council appeared and proved that the Parish Council had been in receipt of rent for the land in question since 1915.

On this evidence I am satisfied that Owslebury Parish Council is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Hampshire County Council, as registration authority, to register Owslebury Parish Council as the owner of the land under section 8(2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
