



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 214/D/146

In the Matter of Parish Quay, Curdridge,
Winchester City, Hampshire.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register-Unit No. VG 182 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Hampshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. OB 659 made by the said Council and noted in the Register on 22 February 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Winchester on 21 March 1979. At the hearing (1) Curdridge Parish Council on whose application the registration was made, were represented by Mr A E M Shave, one of their members; and (2) Hampshire County Council were represented by Mr E Mason, senior assistant solicitor with the Council.

Mr Mason said that the County Council had agreed with the Parish Council that I should confirm the registration with the modification hereinafter specified. I consider I ought to give effect to this agreement, so (Mr Shave being agreeable), I confirm the registration with the modification that there be removed from the Register the part of the land within this Register Unit which is southeast of a straight line of which the north end is on the boundary of the registered land 3 metres distant from the roadside face of the bridge parapet at water level, and of which the south end is the most southeasterly point of the registered land where it meets the corner of the Horse & Jockey Public House (building).

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
