## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 2,7 and 15 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.188 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hampshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 151 made by the Clerk of the former Hampshire County Council and noted in the Register on 27 April 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Winchester on 21 March 1984. The hearing was attended by Mr D Mason, Assistant County Secretary, on behalf of the Hampshire County Council. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the other persons entitled to be heard.

Mr Mason informed me that he was instructed not to pursue the Objection which was met by excluding a strip of land from the Register Unit.

In these circumstances I confirm the registrationg.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
