



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Shedfield Recreation  
Ground, Shedfield, Winchester City,  
Hampshire

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 81 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Hampshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. OB 184 made by the said Council and noted in the Register on 27 May 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Winchester on 21 March 1979. At the hearing (1) Mr F J Osgood on whose application the registration was made, attended in person; and (2) Hampshire County Council were represented by Mr E Mason, senior assistant solicitor with the Council.

Mr Mason said that the County Council had agreed to withdraw the Objection. Accordingly I confirm the registration without any modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
