



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 214/D/133-135

In the Matter of The Old Sand Pit  
Longparish Test Valley D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and the deemed Entry in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.VG.100 in the Register of Town or Village Green maintained by the Hampshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. OB 86 made by Hampshire County Council and noted in the Register on 8 September 1969 and the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.153 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the the dispute at Winchester on 24 July 1979. The hearing was attended by Miss A A Craig on behalf of Hampshire County Council, Mr J E H Spaul and Mr J H Driver on behalf of Longparish Parish Council who registered the land as a village green.

Mr Driver withdrew his councils registration.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
