



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of The Selbourne Recreational
Allotment Whitehill, East Hants D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG.83 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Hampshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. OB 589 made by Hampshire County Council and noted in the Register on 18 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Winchester on 25 July 1979. The hearing was attended by Miss A A Craig who appeared for Hampshire County Council and Mr F J Osgood the applicant also appeared. Miss Craig withdrew the County Councils objection without prejudice to its claim that part of the land was not only a village green but also part of a highway.

For this reason I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
